

**RCW 28A.195.040 Private schools—Board rules for enforcement—
Racial segregation or discrimination prohibited—Board rules for
emergencies.** (1) The state board of education shall promulgate rules
and regulations for the enforcement of RCW 28A.195.010 through
28A.195.040, 28A.225.010, and 28A.305.130, including a provision which
denies approval to any school engaging in a policy of racial
segregation or discrimination.

(2) The state board of education has the authority to make rules
and regulations that establish the terms and conditions for allowing
private schools to maintain their approval status when private schools
are unable to fulfill the requirement of a full school year of one
hundred eighty days or the annual average total instructional hour
offering imposed by RCW 28A.195.010 due to a significant disruption
resulting from an emergency.

(3) For purposes of this section, "emergency" has the same
meaning as "emergency or disaster" in RCW 38.52.010. "Emergency" may
also include a national declaration of emergency by an authorized
