- RCW 29A.04.210 Registration required—Exception. Except for service and overseas voters, only persons registered to vote shall be permitted to vote:
- (1) At any election held for the purpose of electing persons to public office;
 - (2) At any recall election of a public officer;
- (3) At any election held for the submission of a measure to any voting constituency;
 - (4) At any primary election.
