

**RCW 36.39.040 Federal surplus commodities—County expenses—
Handling commodities for certified persons—County program,
cooperative program.** The county commissioners of any county may
expend from the county general fund for the purpose of receiving,
warehousing and distributing federal surplus commodities for the use
of or assistance to recipients of public assistance or other needy
families and individuals when such recipients, families or individuals
are certified as eligible to obtain such commodities by the state
department of social and health services. The county commissioners may
expend county general fund moneys to carry out any such program as a
sole county operation or in conjunction or cooperation with any
similar program of distribution by private individuals or
organizations, any department of the state, or any political
