

RCW 70.250.060 Sexual and reproductive health services—Review and recommendations for improvement—Report to legislature and governor. (1) No later than January 1, 2020, the collaborative shall begin a review to identify, define, and endorse guidelines for the provision of high quality sexual and reproductive health services in clinical settings throughout Washington. This shall include the development of specific clinical recommendations to improve sexual and reproductive health care for:

- (a) People of color;
- (b) Immigrants and refugees;
- (c) Victims and survivors of violence; and
- (d) People with disabilities.

(2) The collaborative shall conduct its review consistent with the activities, processes, and reporting standards specified in RCW 70.250.050. In conducting its review, the collaborative shall apply a whole-person framework to develop evidence-based, culturally sensitive recommendations to improve standards of care and health equity.

(3) By December 15, 2020, the collaborative, through the authority, shall provide a status report to the committees of the legislature with jurisdiction over matters related to health care and to the governor. [2019 c 399 § 6.]
