- RCW 29A.08.172 Registration at age sixteen and seventeen—Application by mail. (1) A person who has attained sixteen years of age may sign up to register to vote, as part of the future voter program, by submitting a voter registration application by mail.
- (2) The applicant must attest to the truth of the information provided on the application by affirmatively accepting the information as true.
- (3) If signing up to register by mail, the person must provide a signature for voter registration purposes.
- (4) The applicant must affirmatively acknowledge that he or she will not vote in a special or general election until his or her eighteenth birthday. [2020 c 208 s 16; 2018 c 109 s 6.]
