RCW 70.129.080 Mail and telephone—Privacy in communications. The resident has the right to privacy in communications, including the right to:

- (1) Send and promptly receive mail that is unopened;
- (2) Have access to stationery, postage, and writing implements at the resident's own expense; and
- (3) Have reasonable access within a reasonable time to the use of a telephone and other communication equipment where calls can be made without being overheard. [2021 c 159 s 25; 1994 c 214 s 9.]
