- RCW 70A.505.060 Collection and management of mercury. (Effective until January 1, 2035.) (1) All mercury-containing lights and materials recovered from mercury-containing lights collected in the state by product stewardship programs or other collection programs must be recycled and any process residuals must be managed in compliance with applicable laws.
- (2) Mercury recovered from retorting and other hazardous materials must be recycled or placed in a properly permitted hazardous waste landfill, or placed in a properly permitted mercury repository. [2024 c 339 s 8; 2010 c 130 s 6. Formerly RCW 70.275.060.]
