WAC 110-305-6225 Physical restraint—Holding method allowed. When a child's behavior makes it necessary for his or her own or another's protection, the licensee or program staff may restrain the child by holding the child as gently as possible. A child must not be physically restrained longer than necessary to control the situation.
