 - [(4)][(d)] Outstanding debts of college employees or students;
 - [(5)][(e)] Loss of eligibility to participate in athletic events;
- [(6)][(f)] Challenges to the contents of education records pursuant to WAC 132M-113-055(2);
 - (g) Mandatory tuition and fee waivers.
