WAC 246-803-220 East Asian medicine sciences. To become an East Asian medicine practitioner, an applicant must have training in East Asian medicine sciences consisting of a minimum of seventy-five quar-ter credits or fifty semester or trimester credits. These credits must include the following subjects of acupuncture/East Asian medicine:

- (1) Fundamental principles;
- (2) Diagnosis;
- (3) Pathology;
- (4) Therapeutics;
- (5) Meridians/vessels and points; and
- (6) Techniques, including electro-acupuncture.
