WAC 246-847-150 Supervised fieldwork experience—Occupational therapy assistants. Supervised fieldwork experience as defined in RCW 18.59.050 (1)(c)(ii) means, for an occupational therapy assistant, a minimum two months, or eight weeks, of full-time equivalency of Level II fieldwork. The Level II fieldwork must be conducted in settings approved by the applicant's academic or training program. Level II fieldwork is to provide an in-depth experience in delivering occupational therapy services to clients and to provide opportunities for supervised practice of occupational therapy assistant entry-level roles. The minimum two months, or eight weeks, of full-time equivalency supervised fieldwork experience required by RCW 18.59.050 (1)(c)(ii) does not include Level I fieldwork experience as defined by the accreditation council for occupational therapy education.
