WAC 296-307-45030 Make sure employees working near dip tanks know appropriate first-aid procedures. The employer must make sure employees know the appropriate first-aid procedures for the hazards of dipping and coating operations.

1. First-aid procedures are contained in the material safety data sheet (MSDS) for the chemicals used in the dip tank.
2. First-aid supplies appropriate for the hazards of the dipping or coating operation need to be located near the dip tank to be considered "readily available" as required by WAC 296-307-03920.

There are additional requirements that may include providing emergency washing facilities and employee training. See first aid, WAC 296-307-039, and employer chemical hazard communication, WAC 296-307-550. Reference:
