WAC 296-806-30024 Safeguard pulleys. You must safeguard pulleys that have any part of the pulley seven feet or less above the floor or working surface.

Reference:

In the absence of a specific safeguarding method, follow the safeguarding requirements found in safeguarding methods, WAC 296-806-20042 through 296-806-20058. Examples of safeguarding methods include:

1. Guards.

3. Safeguarding by distance.4. Safeguarding by location.

EXEMPTION:

You do not need to safeguard pulleys that are in a room, vault, or similar space that contain only power transmission parts or equipment

1. Is controlled by lock and key or has similarly restricted access that allows only authorized persons to enter.

2. Is well lit.

3. Has a dry, level, and firm floor.

4. Has a well-marked route with a vertical clearance of at least five feet six inches for authorized employees to follow to perform their
