WAC 296-863-40040 Meet these requirements when using dock-boards (bridge plates). (1) You must make sure dock-boards are not overloaded:

- (a) Make sure they are strong enough to carry the load imposed on them.
- (b) Make sure loads do not exceed the dock-board's rated capacity.
  - (2) You must do the following when using dock-boards:
  - (a) Drive slowly and carefully over dock-boards;
  - (b) Properly secure dock-boards before driving on them.
- (3) You must make sure powered dock-boards meet the design and construction requirements of U.S. Department of Commerce Commercial Standard CS 202-56 (1961) "Industrial Lifts and Hinged Loading Ramps."
  - (4) You must do the following when using portable dock-boards:
  - (a) Use anchors or other devices that will prevent slipping;
- (b) Make sure they have handholds or other effective means for safe handling.
