WAC 381-100-110 Probable cause review. A probable cause review shall be conducted by the board's designee within forty-eight hours of the board's receipt of the factual allegation(s) to determine whether probable cause exists to believe the violation or violations occurred. A written probable cause finding will be issued. If the hearing officer finds probable cause, the hearing officer will decide if the of-fender will be conditionally released or remain in custody pending further action by the board.
