WAC 246-824-220 Retention of eyeglass and contact lens records. Dispensing opticians shall maintain eyeglass and contact lens records for a minimum of five years.

- (1) Eyeglass records must at a minimum include:
- (a) A copy of the original prescription.

(b) A copy of the refractive powers obtained when neutralizing an eyeglass lens for the purpose of duplicating the lens and the date the lens was neutralized.

- (2) Contact lens records must at a minimum include:
- (a) The written prescription;
- (b) Base curve (posterior radius of curvature);
- (c) Thickness when applicable;
- (d) Secondary/peripheral curve, when applicable;
- (e) Power of lens dispensed;
- (f) Lens material, brand name or manufacturer;
- (g) Diameter, when applicable;
- (h) Suggested wearing schedule and care regimen;
- (i) Color, when applicable.
