- WAC 246-919-355 Examination accepted by the commission. (1) The commission accepts the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE) as the examination for licensure.
- (2) The minimal passing scores for each component of any approved examination combination shall be a score of seventy-five as defined by the examining authority.
- (3) Applicants must have passed all components of the USMLE within seven years after passing the first examination. The commission recognizes that an applicant with a combined degree may require an exception to the seven-year requirement. The commission will review exception requests on a case-by-case basis.
