- WAC 296-874-20020 Provide safe access to scaffolds. (1) You must provide scaffold platforms more than two feet $(0.6\ \text{m})$ above or below a point of access with at least one of the following means of access:
 - (a) Portable, hook-on, or attachable ladder;
 - (b) Stairway-type ladder;
 - (c) Ladder stand;
 - (d) Stair tower (scaffold stairway or tower);
 - (e) Ramp;
 - (f) Walkway;
 - (g) Integral prefabricated scaffold access;
- (h) Direct access from another scaffold, structure, personnel hoist, or similar surface.
- (2) You must make sure crossbraces are not used as a means of access.
