WAC 388-71-1006 What kinds of training topics may be covered in continuing education? Continuing education must be on a topic relevant to the care setting, care needs of clients, or long-term care worker career development. Topics may include but are not limited to:

- (1) Client rights;
- (2) Personal care services;
- (3) Mental illness;
- (4) Dementia;
- (5) Developmental disabilities;
- (6) Depression;
- (7) Medication assistance;
- (8) Communication skills;
- (9) Positive client behavior support;
- (10) Developing or improving client-centered activities;
- (11) Dealing with wandering;
- (12) Dealing with challenging client behaviors;
- (13) Medical conditions; and
- (14) Nurse delegation core and specialized diabetes.
