- WAC 388-825-102 What if I do not want my DDA notices and correspondence sent to anyone else? (1) If you are age eighteen or older and do not have a legal guardian, you may request in writing that your DDA notices and correspondence be given only to you.
- (2) DDA will review your request and comply with your request unless it determines that you are at risk of losing legal rights.
 - (3) You have the right to appeal a denial of this request.
