WAC 388-828-1040 What is the DDA assessment? (1) The DDA assessment is an assessment tool designed to measure the support needs of persons with developmental disabilities.

(2) The DDA assessment consists of:

(a) The support assessment (see WAC 388-828-2000 to 388-828-6020);

(b) The service level assessment (see WAC 388-828-7000 to 388-828-7080); and

(c) The person-centered service plan (PCSP) (see WAC 388-828-8000 to 388-828-8060).

(3) The DDA assessment is part of the comprehensive assessment reporting evaluation system (CARE).
