WAC 388-828-1600 What happens if you refuse to answer a question in the DDA assessment? If you refuse to answer a DDA assessment question that is necessary to determine your service level and DDA is un-able to complete your DDA assessment, DDA will send you or your legal representative notice of denial or termination of eligibility for services as required under chapter 388-825 WAC.
