- (3) The DDA behavioral acuity scale (WAC 388-828-5500 to 388-828-5640);
- (4) The DDA activities of daily living (ADL) acuity scale (WAC 388-828-5380 to 388-828-5480);
- (5) The DDA mobility acuity scale (WAC 388-828-5380 to 388-828-5480); and
- (6) Eligible condition of "autism" as indicated in the DDA determination (WAC 388-823-0500).
