WAC 212-17-280 Permits may not be granted, when. No public display of fireworks will be allowed where the discharge, failure to fire, faulty firing, or fallout of any fireworks or other objects would endanger persons, buildings, structures, forests, brush, or other grass covered land. This includes, but may not be limited to, when a burn ban is in effect.
