- WAC 260-40-120 Identification prerequisite to start. (1) No horse may start that has not been properly identified.
- (2) All horses must be properly tattooed by the thoroughbred racing protective bureau or an approved breed registry, or freeze marked in a manner that meets the standards of the National Crime Information Center.
- A horse will not be allowed to start if a tattoo which is done physically is not applied at least twenty-four hours prior to scheduled post time.
 - (3) No horse may start unless ownership is first established.
