- WAC 296-865-20015 Motor vehicle equipment. (1) You must make sure all equipment operated on public roadways meets all of the state of Washington motor vehicle laws.
  - (2) You must make sure all parts and accessories are safe to use.
- (3) You must make sure all motor vehicle equipment meets the specification or requirements in Table 1.

Seats	1. Properly secured; and
	2. Available for every employee in the vehicle.
Tires	Safe to use.

Fire extinguishers	Provided when the vehicle is:
	1. At least 26,000 pounds (manufacturer's gross weight); and
	2. Only used in the state of Washington.
