- WAC 296-876-40050 Self-supporting ladders. (1) You must make sure self-supporting ladders are not used as single ladders or in the partially closed position.

  (2) You must make sure stepladders are fully opened with the
- spreaders locked.
- (3) You must make sure not to climb on the rear braces of a selfsupporting ladder unless they are designed and recommended for that purpose by the manufacturer.
  - (4) You must prohibit standing or stepping on the:
  - (a) Top cap and top step of a step or trestle ladder.
  - (b) Bucket or pail shelf of a self-supporting ladder.

**EXEMPTION:** The restriction against using the top step is not applicable if it is eighteen inches or more below the top cap.
