WAC 388-97-1520 Tuberculosis—Negative test result. The nursing home may be required by the public health provider or licensing authority to ensure that persons with negative test results have followup testing in certain circumstances, such as:

- (1) After exposure to active tuberculosis;
- (2) When tuberculosis symptoms are present; or
- (3) For periodic testing as determined by the health provider.
