WAC 388-829-0015 What training is required for individuals hired or contracted to work in DDA community residential settings as a direct support professional (DSP) or ISS staff on or after January 1, 2016? Required training for individuals hired or contracted to work in DDA community residential settings as a direct support professional or ISS staff on or after January 1, 2016 consists of seventy-five hours of training as follows:

- (1) Five hours of orientation and safety training as described in WAC 388-829-0045 prior to providing client care or support; and
- (2) Seventy hours of basic training as described in WAC 388-829-0050 must be completed within one hundred twenty days of date of hire.
