It is the responsibility of Wenatchee Valley College to maintain an academic work environment free of sexual harassment, which includes sexual harassment, sexual intimidation and sexual violence. Sexual harassment violates the dignity of individuals and impedes the realization of the college's educational mission. The college is committed to preventing and addressing sexual harassment of faculty, staff and students through education and by encouraging faculty, staff and students to report any concerns or complaints about sexual harassment. Prompt corrective measures will be taken to stop sexual harassment whenever and wherever it occurs.
