WAC 173-175-725 Nonroutine inspections by department. (1) The department may perform nonroutine inspections of dams with any down-stream hazard classification, separate from the periodic inspection program. The purposes for these inspections include, but are not limited to, the following:

(a) Determining downstream hazard classification;

(b) Condition inspections during or immediately after emergencies such as floods or earthquakes;

(c) When problems or conditions arise that may pose a threat to the integrity of the dam;

(d) Obtaining routine monitoring data and information;

(e) Surficial inspections of low hazard dams.

(2) No fees shall be charged to the dam owner for nonroutine inspections.
