- WAC 220-350-050 Definitions—Dressed fish. (1) A dressed fish is defined as one from which the viscera or the viscera and head have been removed, unless otherwise defined by department rule.
- (2) The length of any dressed fish is defined as the shortest distance between the posterior end of the gill opening and the fork of the tail.
