- WAC 296-24-62907 Protection of fire detectors. (1) You must ensure that fire detection equipment installed outdoors or in the presence of corrosive atmospheres be protected from corrosion. The employer shall provide a canopy, hood, or other suitable protection for detection equipment requiring protection from the weather.
- (2) You must locate or otherwise protect detection equipment so that it is protected from mechanical or physical impact which might render it inoperable.
- (3) You must ensure that detectors are supported independently of their attachment to wires or tubing.
