WAC 296-817-50010 Make sure staff conducting audits are properly trained. You must make sure staff conducting hearing protection audits:

- (1) Can demonstrate competence in:
- (a) Evaluating hearing protection attenuation;
- (b) Evaluating hearing protector choices;
- (c) Assessing the correct use of hearing protectors.

(2) Are certified by the Council for Accreditation in Occupational Hearing Conservation (CAOHC) or have training in the following areas:

- (a) Noise and hearing loss prevention;
- (b) Washington state noise regulations;
- (c) Hearing protectors;
- (d) Fitting of hearing protectors;
- (e) Basic noise measurement;
- (f) Hearing loss prevention recordkeeping.
