WAC 296-835-11030 Make sure employees working near dip tanks know appropriate first-aid procedures. You must make sure your employees know the appropriate first-aid procedures for the hazards of your dipping and coating operations.

Note: 1. First-aid procedures are contained in the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for the chemicals used in the dip tank. 2. First-aid supplies appropriate for the hazards of the dipping or coating operation need to be located near the dip tank to be considered "readily available" as required by WAC 296-800-15020.
