- WAC 296-870-20025 Wind and adverse weather. (1) You must prohibit using powered platforms in:
 - (a) Winds exceeding twenty-five miles per hour (40.2 km/hr); or
 - (b) Any other severe adverse weather conditions.
- **EXEMPTION:** Employees may use the platform during severe adverse weather conditions only to move it from an operating to a storage position.
- (2) You must have an anemometer mounted on the platform of an exterior installation to provide on-site wind velocities before and during use of the platform.
- **Note:** 1. Determine wind speed using the best available information, including on-site anemometer readings and local weather forecasts.
 - 2. The anemometer may be a portable or hand held unit which is temporarily mounted during platform use.
