WAC 296-874-20006 Maintain structural integrity when intermixing scaffold components. (1) You must make sure intermixed scaffold components:

- (a) Fit together without force; and
- (b) Maintain the scaffold's structural integrity.
- (2) You must make sure a qualified person determines that modifying components in order to intermix them will result in a structurally sound scaffold.
- (3) You must make sure scaffold components made of different metals are not used together.

**EXEMPTION:** Different types of metals may be used together if a competent person determines that galvanic action will not reduce the strength of any component to less than the minimum strength required.
