WAC 296-874-30006 Make sure counterweights are safe and used properly. (1) You must make sure counterweights:

- (a) Are made of material that cannot flow; and
- (b) Have been specifically designed to be used as counterweights.

Note:

- The following cannot be used as counterweights:
  1. Sand, gravel and similar materials that can be easily dislocated;
  2. Construction material such as masonry units and roofing felt.
- (2) You must secure counterweights to outrigger beams by mechanical means to prevent them from being accidentally detached.
- (3) You must leave counterweights attached to the outrigger beams until after the scaffold has been disassembled.
