WAC 388-71-0906 What topics must be taught in the core competencies of the 70-hour home care aide basic training? Basic training must include all of the competencies under WAC 388-71-0911 for the following topics:

- (1) Communication skills;
- (2) Long-term care worker self-care;
- (3) Problem solving;
- (4) Client rights and maintaining dignity;
- (5) Abuse, abandonment, neglect, financial exploitation, and mandatory reporting;
 - (6) Client directed care;
 - (7) Cultural sensitivity;
 - (8) Body mechanics;
 - (9) Fall prevention;
 - (10) Skin and body care;
 - (11) Long-term care worker roles and boundaries;
 - (12) Supporting activities of daily living;
 - (13) Food preparation and handling;
 - (14) Medication assistance;
 - (15) Infection control and bloodborne pathogens; and
 - (16) Grief and loss.
