WAC 392-501-300 General description. A collection of evidence (COE) is a high school graduation alternative assessment authorized under RCW 28A.655.065 that evaluates a set of work samples in a specific content area (English language arts, science (biology/life science) and mathematics) based on classroom work prepared by a student. Students may prepare a COE for one or more content areas.
