AMENDING ORDER NO. 1014 dated May 31, 1966, and
Emergency Amendment dated July 25, 1966


The adoption of this Permanent Amendment to Order No. 1014 is necessary for the correction of an error in the original Order No. 1014.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Donald W. Moos, Director of Agriculture of the State of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 15.17 RCW and Chapter 34.04 RCW, establish the following Amendment to Order No. 1014.

Regulation C, Section 3, is hereby amended to read:

"In order to allow for variations incident to proper sizing, not more than ten percent, by count, of the peaches in any lot may be below the specified minimum size and not more than fifteen percent may be above any specified maximum size."
