ORDER 589

REGULATION GOVERNING THE IMPORTATION OF BOVINE SEMEN  
INTO THE STATE OF WASHINGTON

I, Sverre N. Omdahl, Director of Agriculture of the State of Washington, by virtue of authority vested in me under Section 3, Chapter 172 Laws of 1947 (3113 Rem. Supp. 1947) do make and issue the following regulations governing the importation of bovine semen into the State of Washington.

Regulation 1. Permission in writing from the Director of Agriculture must be obtained before bovine semen may be shipped into the State of Washington.

Regulation 2. The Director of Agriculture must be furnished an approved Health Certificate on all bulls from which the semen is collected.

Regulation 3. A sample of semen from each bull must be tested at an official laboratory in the State of Washington and certified to be free from organisms which spread infectious diseases.
