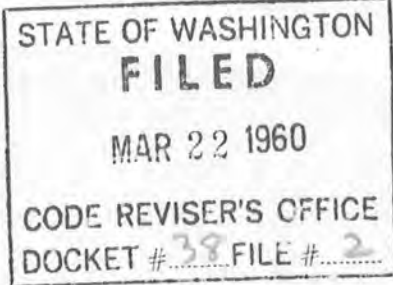





REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE REPORTING OF DISEASES

I, Sverre N. Omdahl, Director of Agriculture of the State of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 16.36 Revised Code of Washington, do make and issue the following regulation relating to the reporting of diseases:

1. The following diseases shall be reported to the Supervisor of the Division of Dairy and Livestock, Department of Agriculture, Olympia, Washington:

Anaplasmosis	Lip-and-leg ulceration
Anthrax	Listeriosis
Bacillary hemoglobinuria	Malignant catarrhal fever
Blackleg	Malignant edema
Blue tongue	Newcastle disease
Brucellosis	Paratyphoid
Contagious ecthyma	Piroplasmosis
Equine encephalomyelitis	Pseudorabies
Enterotoxemia	Psittacosis
Erysipelas	Pullorum disease
Foot-rot (sheep)	Rabies
Foot-and-mouth disease	Rinderpest
Fowl typhoid	Scabies
Glanders	Scrapie
Infectious hemorrhagic dysentery	Swamp fever
Infectious keratitis	Trichomoniasis
Infectious necrotic hepatitis	Tuberculosis
Johne's disease	Vesicular Exanthema
Laryngotracheitis	Vesicular stomatitis
Leptospirosis	Vibrionic abortion
