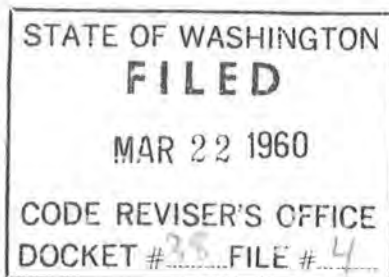


Order No. 761

Effective January 1, 1958

I, Joe Dwyer, Director of Agriculture, State of Washington, after due notice and public hearing held on October 23, 1957, in Spokane, Washington, and by virtue of the authority vested in me by Chapter 80, Laws of 1953, and Chapter 15.53, RCW, Washington Commercial Feed Law of 1953, do hereby promulgate the following regulation to read as follows:

Pea Meal is a ground product resultant from the grinding of whole peas and all the kernel, all of the germ, and all of the bran therein contained which is reasonably free of other crop plants, weeds and mold. It shall contain not less than 21% crude protein and not more than 6% crude fiber.
