REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE USE OF THE INSECTICIDE  
1-NAPHTHYL-n-METHYLCARBAMATE (SEVIN)

I, Joe Dwyer, Director of Agriculture, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 17.21, RCW, Laws of 1961, after due notice as provided under Chapter 34.04 and 42.32, RCW and a public hearing held in Yakima on February 7, 1962, do promulgate the following regulations relating to the restricted use of the insecticide Sevin.

Regulation 1. Pesticide and Area Under Order. The agricultural pesticide 1-Naphthyl-n-methylcarbamate, hereafter referred to in this Order as Sevin, is by this order declared to be a restricted-use pesticide in certain designated areas of Yakima, Benton, Franklin, Adams, and Grant Counties in the State of Washington.

Regulation 2. Areas Under Order. Area Number 1 includes all of the irrigable lands East of a line beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 16, Township 8 North, Range 22 East of Willamette Meridian; thence North to the Bond Road and following the Bond Road northerly 4 miles, more or less, to Highway 3A; thence Northwest 3 miles, more or less, along Highway 3A to a point  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile South of the Northwest corner of Section 19, TWN9N, R22E.W.M.; thence North  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Section 18, TWN11N, R22E.W.M. and including all of the irrigable land in Benton County.

Area Number 2 includes all of the irrigable lands encompassed by a boundary line beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 18, TWN8N, R21E.W.M.; thence North 15 miles, more or less, to the Southeast corner of Section 36, TWN11N, R20E.W.M. (Southern tip of the town of Zillah); thence Northwest following the Yakima River 15 miles, more or less, to a point  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile East of the Northwest corner of Section 20, TWN12N, R19E.W.M.; thence East 17 miles, more or less, to the Northeast corner of Section 24, TWN12N, R21E.W.M.; thence South  $18\frac{1}{2}$  miles, more or less, to Highway 3A; thence Southeast, following Highway 3A, for 3 miles, more or less, to the Bond Road; thence following the Bond Road Southerly to its end and thence South to the Southeast corner of Section 17, TWN8N, R21E.W.M., the point of beginning.

Area Number 3 includes all irrigable lands encompassed by a boundary line beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 34, TWN10N, R18E.W.M.; thence North 15 miles, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Section 22, TWN12N, R18E.W.M.; thence East  $4\frac{1}{4}$  miles, more or less, to the Yakima River; thence following the Yakima River Southeast to the Southeast corner of Section 36, TWN11N, R20E.W.M. (Southern tip of the town of Zillah); thence South 6 miles, more or less, to the Southeast corner of Section 36, TWN10N, R20E.W.M.; thence 15 miles West, more or less, to the Southwest corner of Section 34, TWN10N, R18E.W.M., the point of beginning.

Area Number 4 includes all irrigable lands in the Yakima Indian Reservation West of a line starting at the Southwest corner of Section 34, TWN10N, R18E.W.M.; thence North 13 miles, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Section 27, TWN12N, R18E.W.M.

Area Number 5 includes all irrigable lands in Grant, Adams, and Franklin counties which are within the Columbia Basin Irrigation Project.

Regulation 3. Limitations on the uses of Sevin in the following areas:

Area Number 1. This area is unrestricted as to the use of Sevin on corn in any combination or formulation prior to July 13 of any given year. Sevin may be used in this area from July 13 of any given year to August 12 of any given year, inclusive, only in a combination of not more than 0.8 pounds of actual Sevin and not less than 0.8 pounds of actual Malathion or another approved pesticide per application per acre. After August 2 of any given year, this area is completely restricted as to the use of Sevin in any combination or formulation on corn which is actively shedding pollen.

Area Number 2. There shall be no applications of Sevin in any combination or formulation on corn which is actively shedding pollen prior to August 15 of any given year; PROVIDED, that Sevin may be used on corn after August 15 of any given year.


Area Number 3. This area is unrestricted as to the use of Sevin, in any combination or formulation, on corn.

Area Number 4. This area is completely restricted as to the use of Sevin in any combination or formulation on corn which is actively shedding pollen.

Area Number 5. Sevin may be used on corn which is actively shedding pollen only in a combination of not more than 0.8 pounds of actual Sevin and not less than 0.8 pounds of actual Malathion or another approved pesticide, per application per acre.

Regulation 4. Applications of Sevin in any formulation on any crop whether or not in blossom shall be made in such a manner as to prevent drift into or upon colonies or beds of pollinating insects.
