ORDER NO. 889

Amending Order No. 887

Effective June 11, 1962

I, Joe Dwyer, Director of Agriculture, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 17.21 RCW do promulgate the following emergency regulation relating to the use and application of the pesticide endrin on blossoming alfalfa and blossoming clover crops.


The adoption of this emergency Order No. 889 restricting the use of the pesticide endrin is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. It is necessary that this Order become effective immediately since the spraying of pesticides has commenced in the State of Washington.

Regulation 3 of Order No. 887 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The use or application of the following listed pesticides or any formulation thereof on blossoming alfalfa and clover crops is restricted to applications only within the period beginning at two hours prior to sunset and ending at two and one-half hours after sunrise the following morning. Blossoming period of alfalfa or clover in a given field is whenever there are two or more blooms per square yard on the average. PROVIDED, THAT endrin may only be applied to blossoming clover crops pursuant to this regulation and its application to blossoming alfalfa shall be made pursuant to regulation 5 of Order No. 887.
