REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE USE OF INSECTICIDES  
ON CORN IN THE YAKIMA VALLEY AREA

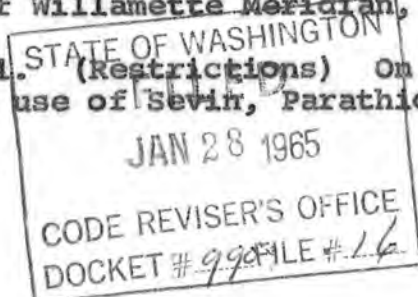
I, Cameron Adams, Acting Director of Agriculture, of the State of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 17.21 RCW, after due notice as provided under Chapters 34.04 and 42.32 RCW, and a public hearing held in Yakima on December 22, 1964 do hereby promulgate the following regulations relating to the restricted use of insecticides on corn actively shedding pollen.

Regulation 1. Definition: The term "actively shedding pollen" as related to corn in this Order shall be that stage of growth when 10% or more of the corn plants in a field are showing spike anthers.

Regulation 2. Restricted Insecticides. The agricultural insecticides 1-Naphthyl-n-methyl carbamate, hereafter referred to as Sevin; O, O-diethyl O-p-nitrophenyl thiophosphate, hereafter referred to as Parathion; O, O-dimethyl O-p-nitrophenyl phosphorothioate, hereafter referred to as Methyl Parathion; and S-(1,2-dicarbethoxyethyl) O, O-dimethyl dithiophosphate, hereafter referred to as Malathion; are by this Order declared to be restricted use insecticides. Such insecticides are restricted in their use in certain designated areas of Yakima and Benton counties of the State of Washington.

Regulation 3. Area Number 1. (Early Corn Area) This area includes all of the irrigable lands East of a line beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 9, Township 7 North, Range 22 East of Willamette Meridian; thence North to the Bond Road and following the Bond Road Northerly 4 miles, more or less, to Highway 3A; thence Northwest 3 miles, more or less, along Highway 3A to a point  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile South of the Northwest corner of Section 19, Township 9 North, Range 22 East of Willamette Meridian; thence North 8 miles, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Section 7, Township 10 North, Range 22 East of Willamette Meridian (Junction of the Decker and Independence Roads); East two miles along the Independence road to the Northwest corner of Section 9, Township 10, Range 22 East of Willamette Meridian (junction of the Independence and Pipe Line Roads); thence North 10 miles, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Section 21, Township 12 North, Range 22 East of Willamette Meridian; and West of a line beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 8, Township 7 North, Range 27 East of Willamette Meridian; thence North to the Weber Canyon Road; thence Northerly along the Weber Canyon Road to Kiona and the Yakima River; thence Northerly along the Yakima River to the U. S. Military Reservation boundary at the Southwest corner of Section 19, Township 10 North, Range 27 East of Willamette Meridian. In addition, all irrigable lands encompassed by a line starting at the Columbia River and the Southeast corner of Section 8, Township 7 North, Range 31 East of Willamette Meridian; thence West 5 miles, more or less, to the Nine Canyon Road; thence Northerly along the Nine Canyon Road to the Haney Road; thence North on the Haney Road to the Bowles Road; thence Westerly on the Bowles Road to the Swayze Road; thence North on the Swayze Road to the Columbia River; thence Southeasterly along the Columbia River to the Southeast corner of Section 8, Township 7 North, Range 31 East of Willamette Meridian, the point of beginning.

Area 1. (Restrictions) On and after August 1 of any given year, the use of Sevin, Parathion, and Methyl Parathion in



any combination or formulation on corn which is actively shedding pollen is prohibited. On and after August 1 of any given year, the application of Malathion is prohibited between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on corn that is actively shedding pollen. On and after August 15 of any given year, the application of Malathion is also prohibited at any time on corn that is actively shedding pollen: Provided, That prior to August 1 of any given year, this area is unrestricted as to the use of Sevin, Parathion, Methyl Parathion, and Malathion on corn in any combination or formulation.

Regulation 4. Area Number 2. (Late Corn Area) This area includes all of the irrigable lands encompassed by a line beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 7, Township 7 North, Range 21 East of Willamette Meridian; thence North 20 miles, more or less, to the Southeast corner of Section 36, Township 11 North, Range 20 East of Willamette Meridian (Southern tip of Zillah); thence Northwest to the junction of the Cheyne Road and Highway 410 (Northwest tip of Zillah); thence North on the Cheyne Road and its extension to the Northwest corner of Section 24, Township 12 North, Range 20 East of Willamette Meridian; thence East 9 miles, more or less, to the Northeast corner of Section 20, Township 12 North, Range 22 East of Willamette Meridian; thence South 10 miles, more or less, to the Southeast corner of Section 5, Township 10 North, Range 22 East of Willamette Meridian (junction of the Pipe Line and Independence Road); thence West 2 miles to the Southwest corner of Section 6, Township 10 North, Range 22 East of Willamette Meridian (junction of the Decker and Independence Roads); thence South 8 miles, more or less, to Highway 3A; thence Southeast, following Highway 3A for 3 miles, more or less, to the Bond Road; thence Southerly on the Bond Road to its end; thence South to the Southwest corner of Section 9, Township 7 North, Range 22 East of Willamette Meridian; thence West 8 miles, more or less, to the Southeast corner of Section 7, Township 7 North, Range 21 East of Willamette Meridian, the point of beginning.

Area 2. (Restrictions) Prior to August 15 of any given year, in the above described area, the application of Sevin, Parathion, and Methyl Parathion in any combination or formulation is prohibited on corn which is actively shedding pollen. Also prior to August 15, of any given year the application of Malathion is prohibited between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on corn which is actively shedding pollen: Provided, That on and after August 15 of any given year, this area is unrestricted as to the use of Sevin, Parathion, Methyl Parathion, and Malathion on corn.

Regulation 5. Area Number 3. (Unrestricted) This area includes all irrigable lands encompassed by a line beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 34, Township 10 North, Range 18 East of Willamette Meridian; thence North 15 miles, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Section 22, Township 12 North, Range 18 East of Willamette Meridian; thence East 4 miles, more or less, to the Northern Pacific Railroad tracks; thence following the tracks Southeast to the Oldenway Road; thence North on the Oldenway Road and section lines to the Yakima River; thence Southeast along the Yakima River to Highway 97, North of Toppenish; thence North on Highway 97 to Highway 410 at Buena; thence Southeasterly along Highway 410 to the Southeast corner of Section 36, Township 11 North, Range 20 East of Willamette Meridian (Southern tip of Zillah); thence South 6 miles, more or less, to the Southeast corner of Section 36, Township 10 North, Range 20 East of Willamette Meridian; thence 15 miles West, more or less, to the Southwest corner of Section 34, Township 10 North, Range 18 East of Willamette Meridian, the point of beginning. Also all irrigable lands lying within Benton County, East of a line beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 8, Township 7 North, Range 27 East of Willamette Meridian; thence North to the Weber Canyon Roads; thence Northerly along the


Weber Canyon Road to Kiona and the Yakima River; thence Northerly along the Yakima River to the U. S. Military Reservation at the Southwest corner of Section 19, Township 10 North, Range 27 East of Willamette Meridian; to a line starting at the South section line of Section 9, Township 7 North, Range 30 East of Willamette Meridian and the Nine Canyon Road; thence Northerly along the Nine Canyon Road to the Haney Road; thence North on the Haney Road to the Bowles Road; thence Westerly on the Bowles Road to the Swayze Road; thence North on the Swayze Road to the Columbia River.

Area 3. (Restrictions) This area is unrestricted as to the use of Sevin, Parathion, Methyl Parathion, and Malathion in any combination or formulation, on corn.

Regulation 6. Area Number 4. (Restricted) This area includes all irrigable lands in the Yakima Indian Reservation West of a line starting at the Southwest corner of Section 34, Township 10 North, Range 18 East of Willamette Meridian; thence North 15 miles, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Section 22, Township 12 North, Range 18 East of Willamette Meridian. Also all irrigable lands encompassed by a line beginning at a point 1/4 mile East of the Northwest corner of Section 20, Township 12 North, Range 19 East of Willamette Meridian; thence Southeasterly along the Northern Pacific Railroad tracks to the Oldenway Road; thence North on the Oldenway Road and section lines to the Yakima River; thence Southeasterly along the Yakima River to Highway 97 North of Toppenish; thence North on Highway 97 to Highway 410 at Buena; thence Southeast along Highway 410 to the Cheyne Road; thence North on the Cheyne Road and its extension to the Northeast corner of Section 23, Township 12 North, Range 20 East of Willamette Meridian; thence West 10 miles, more or less, to a point 1/4 mile East of the Northwest corner of Section 20, Township 12 North, Range 19 East of Willamette Meridian, the point of beginning.

Area 4. (Restrictions) The use of Sevin, Parathion, and Methyl Parathion in any combination or formulation on corn which is actively shedding pollen is prohibited. The application of Malathion on corn that is actively shedding pollen is prohibited between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.
