ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 20

(1) I, William L. Hart, Supervisor, Division of Banking, Department of General Administration, an agency of the State of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under chapter 34.04 RCW, RCW 43.19.040, RCW 30.04.030, RCW 30.08.095, section 33, chapter 53, Laws of 1973, 1st ex. sess., section 8, chapter 104, Laws of 1973, 1st ex. sess., Title 30 RCW, and chapter 53, Laws of 1973, 1st ex. sess., after filing Notice No. 4144 with the Code Reviser, and mailing the notice to all persons who had made timely requests of the Division of Banking and of the Department of General Administration for advance notice of its rule-making proceedings, and giving public notice as provided in chapter 42.30 RCW, held a meeting open to the public at the Office of the Supervisor of Banking, 111B General Administration Building, Olympia, Washington, on Monday, August 6, 1973, at 9:00 a.m. and after considering all written and oral comments, do promulgate and adopt the annexed rules and regulations, to wit: AMD WAC 50-12-040, as permanent rules of this agency.

(2) This order, after being first recorded in the Order Register of this agency, shall be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing pursuant to chapter 34.04 RCW and chapter 1-12 WAC.

WAC 50-12-040 SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR BANKS, TRUST COMPANIES, AND ALIEN BANKS. The supervisor shall collect in advance the following fees:

(1) \$2,000.00 for filing application for a certificate of authority and attendant investigation for a new bank or trust company. If the cost therefor (computed on the basis of \$15.00 per man hour devoted by the division of banking to processing and investigating the application) exceeds \$2,000.00, the applicant shall pay such excess when ascertained by the supervisor.

(2) \$1,500.00 for filing an application for certificate authorizing an alien bank to establish and operate an office in the State of Washington and attendant investigation. If the cost therefor (computed on the basis of \$15.00 per man hour devoted by the division of banking to processing and investigating the application) exceeds \$1,500.00, the applicant shall pay such excess when ascertained by the supervisor.

(3) \$300.00 for filing an application for certificate authorizing an alien bank to establish and operate a bureau in the State of Washington. If the cost therefor (computed on the basis indicated in (1) and (2) above) exceeds \$300.00, the applicant shall pay such excess when ascertained by the supervisor.

(4) \$300.00 for filing an application for a certificate of authority for a branch and attendant investigation. If the cost therefor (computed on the basis of \$15.00 per man hour devoted by the division of banking to processing and investigating the application) exceeds \$300.00, the applicant shall pay such excess when ascertained by the supervisor.

(5) \$500.00 for filing an application for a certificate conferring trust powers and attendant investigation. If the cost therefor (computed on the basis of \$15.00 per man hour devoted by the division of banking to processing and investigating the application) exceeds \$500.00, the applicant shall pay such excess when ascertained by the supervisor.

(6) \$2,000.00 for filing merger agreement and attendant investigation. If three or more banks are involved, then the fee for each is \$1,000.00. If the cost therefor (computed on the basis of \$15.00 per man hour devoted by the division of banking to processing and investigating the application) exceeds the specified fee, the applicant surviving bank shall pay such excess when ascertained by the supervisor.

(7) \$200.00 for filing an application for a certificate of appropriate adjunct and attendant investigation. If the cost therefor (computed on the basis of \$15.00 per man hour devoted by the division of banking to processing and investigating the application) exceeds \$200.00, the applicant shall pay such excess when ascertained by the supervisor.

(8) \$100.00 for filing application to relocate main office or branch and attendant investigation. If the cost therefor (computed on the basis of \$15.00 per man hour devoted by the division of banking to processing and investigating the application) exceeds \$100.00, the applicant shall pay such excess when determined by the supervisor.

(9) \$25.00 for issuing each branch certificate for branch resulting from merger.

(10) \$25.00 for filing articles of incorporation, or amendments thereof, or other certificates required to be filed with the supervisor.

(11) \$25.00 for issuing a certificate of increase or decrease of capital stock or issuing a certificate of authority.

(12) Fifty cents per page for furnishing copies of papers filed with the supervisor.
