COLLECTIVE BARGAINING RELATING TO TENURE

WAC 132R-130-010 This rule is adopted pursuant to the requirement of RCW 28B.50.852 and in accordance herewith it is declared that the collective bargaining agreement and/or policies of the college shall contain provisions relating to the following subject matter areas of implementation regarding tenure and shall be consistent with the laws of the State of Washington: recommendations for tenure; reduction in force procedures; dismissal procedures; hearing procedures; rights of appeal.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested in us by RCW 28B.50.140, and because of the requirements of RCW 28B.19, we, the Board of Trustees for Washington State Community College District No. 18, do hereby find that the preservation of the general welfare of Big Bend Community College requires the adoption of rules governing collective bargaining relating to tenure;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the attached COLLECTIVE BARGAINING RELATING TO TENURE, WAC 132R-130, is hereby approved and adopted as permanent rules of Big Bend Community College.
