SUBJECT: Corrections to WAC 51-10

The State Building Code Council has made the following editorial corrections to the Washington State Regulations for Barrier-Free Facilities WAC 51-10.

**Correction #1**

Page 1 Sec. 001 add comma after RCW 19.27.

**Correction #2**

Page 6 Sec. 511(a) - Capitalize Section, Accessible and Opening in the second paragraph.

**Correction #3**

Page 9 Sec. 511.(e) - Move paragraph relating to thresholds down below the next paragraph so that it immediately precedes the exception.

**Correction #4**

Page 18 Sec. 3306(m) - Exception 2.

Delete 2. and move the sub section to the left on the page so that it is printed as a regular provision rather than an exception.

**Correction #5**

Page 21 Sec. 5107 - First sentence - delete the first use of the word "installed".

Page 22 Sec. 5501(b)2. - First paragraph add an s to the word "second".

**Correction #7**

Page 23 Sec. 5502(a) - Third sentence - change the word "greater" to less.

**Correction #8**

Page 26 Sec. 7502(i) - The word "greater" in the second sentence is changed to the word less.

**Correction #9**

Page 26 Sec. 7502(k) - The last sentence was omitted in the publication of the 1986 regulations. The following sentence is added at the end of the section:

Handrails shall not be required at any point of access along the ramp, nor at any curb cut.
